
- Turnover has decreased 35%

- Enquires plummeted by 62%





## Comments


- "85% of projects are slabs. Composite decking is a big thing. More exciting gardens bigger budgets."
- "Clients are more aware of the money they are spending now. People are prepared to spend more money for skills (especially on patios)"
- "Design enquiries still coming through albeit slower but conversion rate on the build is very poor, not because they are going elsewhere, I think clients are holding off with the uncertain times ahead and just planning for the future."
- "The enquiries are there still but we have noticed we are winning less work, we think this is down to costs still. However a lot previous clients have come back this month to work on additional projects."
- "Increase over August/September is seasonal."
- "Lots of financial uncertainty I suspect is suppressing the market. The price of implementing a garden build these days has gone up by at least 50% compared with 18 months ago."
- "As with everyone else, there is great uncertainty. Next years production has to be planned now and its difficult to know how much to produce."




